Wisdom Mission School Enrollment Contract

For U. S. Resident Students

Both parents, guardians, or other persons responsible for payments should read all the provisions of this Contract, complete the required information, sign and return the Contract to the Admission Office accompanied by all tuition, enrollment and other fees, which are due upon submission of this Contract. A student is accepted for enrollment or re-enrollment when the Contract has been delivered to the School, countersigned and dated. Amendments to this Contract and alterations or addition to the printed terms hereof will be effective with the approval of the School's Board of Trustees.

In consideration of the acceptance of this Contract by the School, the undersigned agrees to pay the required TOTAL TUITION for the full academic year and any additional fees incurred and agrees to be bound by the provisions of this Contract.

Enrollment and Re-enrollment is conditioned upon the following terms:

1. Successful completion of the current academic year and recommendation of the School is required for re-enrollment of currently enrolled students.
2. All tuition, enrollment fees and other fees are due upon submission of this enrollment contract UNLESS prior payment plan is arranged by the school. This payment for tuition, enrollment fees and other fees are non-refundable after enrollment is completed. When the prior payment arrangement is made tuition and fees payments must be received by the School on or before each due date. A separate Contract is required for the payment arrangement.
3. After the semester begins, students cannot be accepted. If an exception is made to accept the student, a full tuition is charged.
4. Admission will be cancelled if undisclosed facts about student are discovered in the future, and the tuition and fees payments are not refundable.
5. The School reserves the right to suspend or dismiss a student anytime when the tuition payments become delinquent by more than 15 days.
6. The School reserves the right to dismiss a student or request parent(s), guardian, or any other persons responsible for the student to withdraw from school if the student has unsatisfactory academic standing and/or unsatisfactory behavior in accordance with Wisdom Mission School Policies.
7. The student and the student's family/guardian agree to comply with and be subject to the School's rules and policies as set forth in the Student Handbook, as amended from time to time.
8. The credits earned from Wisdom Mission School may not be transferable to other public or private schools. **Initial**()
9. Transcripts will be held for students until all unpaid tuition and fees are received.
10. Tuition is non-refundable when student chooses to withdraw from WMS, or the student is expelled from WMS.
11. The terms and provisions on the reverse side of this Contract must be completed and are included as of this Contract by reference.

- 1. Enrollment Fee: \$700 – Only for the New Students
- 2. Other Fees: \$500 – Copies, Internet Use, Activities, Etc.
- 3. Graduation Fee: To Be Determined – Only for the Seniors

- 5. Tuition: \$9,000 – For Semester 1 and 2, excluding Summer School

Summer School Information

- 1. To make-up any of subjects, you must pre-arrange with the School during the Fall/Spring Semester at the Administration Office.
- 2. Summer School tuitions: \$1,200 per subject or depending on the class.
- 3. Summer School tuitions can be changed without any notice.

Student Rules & Regulations

- 1. Academic Scholarship is renewable every semester if you are the current recipient
- 2. After the semester starts, class schedule cannot be adjusted to any individual students' needs.
- 3. All students are required to follow the school – established class schedules.
